DAUPHIN COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

This Authority is a public instrumentality of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and a body public, corporate and politic created under the Pennsylvania Economic Development Financing Law, Act of August 23, 1967, P.L. 251, as amended and supplemented (the "Act") by action of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Dauphin. It exists and operates as a public instrumentality of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for, among other things, the public purposes of alleviating unemployment, maintaining employment at a high level, eliminating and preventing blight, eliminating or reducing air and water pollution, and creating and developing business opportunities by the construction, improvement, rehabilitation, revitalization and financing of industrial, commercial and manufacturing enterprises.

Projects eligible to be financed by the Authority are subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners of Dauphin County, after a public hearing, and the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development as required by the Act. The financing of approved projects involves the issuance by the Authority of tax-exempt and taxable obligations (typically revenue and mortgage-backed bonds). Pursuant to the requirements of the Act, the obligations are special and limited obligations of the Authority, payable solely from the revenues of the project financed and other security from the beneficiary of the financing. The obligations, as specified by the Act, do not constitute a debt of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or any political subdivision thereof, including the County of Dauphin, and neither the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania nor any political subdivision thereof, including the County of Dauphin are liable thereon.
