GENERAL INFORMATION

QUALIFICATIONS:

Citizen of the United States

Resident of Dauphin County

Registered to vote at current address

(Unless Student Election Worker)

Available to work in any part of Dauphin County (if necessary)

HOURS:

Election workers report to their assigned location no later than 6:15 AM to prepare and set up the room for polls to open.

Polls are open from 7:00 AM until 8:00 PM

After 8:00 PM, election workers assist the Judge of Election in compiling results and closing polls

PAY:

Judge of Election—\$170.00 and \$20.00 for training (plus mileage for delivery of materials)

Inspectors—\$140.00 (plus \$20 for training)

Clerks/Machine Operators \$130 (plus \$20 for training)

JUDGE OF ELECTION RESPONSIBILITIES:

Responsible for operations at the polls

Notifies election office of absences

Assigns duties to election board

Provides directions in setting up polls

Officially opens polls at 7:00 AM

Manages processing of voters

Officially closes polls at 8:00 PM

Responsible for the return of voting supplies to designated drop-off site on election night

ELECTION BOARD MEMBERS:

Assist the Judge of Election and share responsibilities of operating poll site including but not limited to

Opening and setting up polls

Posting signs

Greeting voters

Process voters

Assisting voters as needed

Assisting in closing the polls

TRAINING:

Mandatory attendance at a two-hour training session (paid \$20 included along with your Election Day pay)

Training pay applicable only if you work on Election

Day

Take home training manual is provided
